The <u>other</u> tribes anointed Saul's other son, Ishbosheth, as their King (not endorsed by God) and never seemed to think a moment of David. (R4234)

- 2Sa 5:2 when Saul was king over us, <u>you</u> led out and out and brought in Israel: and the LORD said to you, you shalt feed my people Israel, and thou shalt be a captain [ruler] over Israel.
