TS 81 p 3-4

"And he brought the burnt-offering and offered it according to the [usual] manner. And he brought the meat- offering, and took a handful of it and offered it upon the altar beside the burnt-sacrifice of the morning. He slew also the bullock and the ram for a sacrifice of peace-offerings which was for the people." Lev 9:16-18

"The peace-offering, as already described, represented a vow or covenant."

What is this vow or covenant?

Consecration to sacrifice - Lev 8

Contract between each of us and God

Peace Offering – Something different

Ask ourselves...

Church's work after Sin-Offering is complete?

Look at the type... (TS81 p3-4)

"In the type the peace was established between Jehovah and Israel as follows: The sin-offering having been made, also the burnt-offering showing the acceptableness of it to God, there was peace between Jehovah and Israel, because their former Adamic sin was typically removed; and they were obligated then to live obedient to a covenant based on their forgiveness--i.e., they were to keep the Law - that he that doeth those things should live by (or as a reward for keeping) them."

TS 81 p 3-4

"Made in connection with the sin-offering of the High Priest, it signified the <u>vows</u>, <u>obligations</u> and <u>covenants</u> <u>assumed by the Priest</u>, <u>based on the sin-offering</u>."

After the sin-offering...

then comes the peace offering

What we covenant to do... *after* sin-offering is complete. ¹⁰

Priests' Typical Responsibilities...

(Lev 26:3 KJV) If ye <u>walk in my statutes</u>, and <u>keep my</u> commandments, and do them;

(Lev 26:11 KJV) And <u>I will set my tabernacle among you</u>: and my soul shall not abhor you.

(Lev 26:12 KJV) And <u>I will walk among you, and will be your</u> God, and ye shall be my people.

(Deu 31:11,12 KJV) When all Israel is come to appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing. Gather the people together, men, and women, and children, and thy stranger that is within thy gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear the LORD your God, and observe to do all the words of this law:

Type – Priests enforced the Law Covenant 12

TS 81 p 3-4 Antitype...

"But as our sin-sacrifices are better than the typical ones, so with the peace-offering or covenant established by those sacrifices; it is a <u>better covenant</u>."

(Heb 8:8,10 KJV) ... Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: ...I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:

How?? - through the Christ Head and Body

TS 81 p 3-4

"Thus in this sacrifice of peace, or covenant-offering, the Priest is seen to serve unto the example and shadow of spiritual things--the mediator of a better covenant (Heb. 8:6-13), under which all people shall be blessed with RESTITUTION, and thus be enabled to obey the perfect law and live forever."

THIS is the job of Christ – Head and Body – when complete.

Peace offering of the People

(Deu 31:12 KJV) ... that they may hear, and that they may learn, and fear (reverence) the LORD your God, and observe to <u>do</u> all the words of this law:

Then... eternal, perfect peace

TS 93 SACRIFICES SUBSEQUENT TO THE "DAY OF ATONEMENT"

TS 94p1

"Day of Atonement" sacrifices - basis for all offerings of the Mediatorial phase of the Kingdom

TS 94p4

pointed back to or recognized the sacrifices of the Day of Atonement

TS 95p0

Cattle, sheep, fowl, doves, pigeons, fine flour... indicating <u>ability</u> of the offerer

TS 95-96 Burnt Offerings and Peace Offerings

TS 95p1

However degraded by sin and imperfect, each must, when he comes to a knowledge of the truth, present himself to God, the <u>offering indicating his</u> condition.

TS 96p0

...these burnt-offerings and peace-offerings of the future represent the people as <u>consecrating</u>-giving themselves to the Lord

TS 98 The People's Peace-Offerings

This offering was to be of the <u>herd or flock</u>; and it could be made either in <u>fulfillment</u> of a vow (covenant), or as a willing "thank-offering."

This seems to show that if any man will then come into a condition of <u>full peace and harmony</u> (as all must do <u>or else be cut off in the Second Death</u>), he must eat or <u>fulfill a covenant</u> before God of <u>entire consecration</u> to him.

Herd or flock - human perfection - when ? - 2874

Rev. 20:9,13-15

Rev. 20: 7, 9,13-15

2874

(Rev 20:7 KJVR) And when the thousand years are expired Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,

(Rev 20:9 KJVR) And they... compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and <u>fire came down from God</u> out of heaven, and devoured them.

(Rev 20:13 KJVR) And the sea gave up the dead... death and hell delivered up the dead... and they were judged every man according to their works.

(Rev 20:14 KJVR) And $\underline{\text{death and hell were cast into the lake of }}$ fire. This is the second death.

(Rev 20:15 KJVR) And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

TS 98 The People's Peace-Offerings

With this sacrifice ... (herd or flock)

unleavened cakes mingled with oil, anointed wafers,

faith in Christ's character which he will copy, and...

leavened bread indicating his acknowledgment of his own imperfection at the time of consecration--leaven being a type of sin. Lev. 7:11-13

Note: He can <u>now</u> fulfill his covenant (herd or flock) but each will remember his *initial* imperfection

Little Season

Who will stand??

<u>ONLY</u> those who offered bullocks [perfect sacrifices] upon thine altar." (Psa. 51:19)

Who have <u>fully consecrated</u> their <u>perfected ALL</u> to God forever

Their answer to the question...

What will you do with perfection?

Do God's will perfectly forever, from the heart

Exodus 24:3-8

(Exo 24:3 KJV) Moses ... told the people all the words of the LORD, ... **All the words** which the LORD hath said **will we do**.

(Exo 24:5 KJV) And he sent <u>young men</u> of the children of Israel, which offered <u>burnt offerings</u>, and sacrificed <u>peace offerings</u> of oxen unto the LORD.

(Exo 24:6 KJV) And Moses took <u>half of the blood</u>, and put it in basons; and half of the blood he sprinkled on the <u>altar</u>.

(Exo 24:7 KJV) And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, <u>All that the LORD hath</u> said will we do, and be obedient.

(Exo 24:8 KJV) And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words.
