Obey – Strong's H8085 (Shama) verb

- To Hear, Listen to, Obey
- Give Heed
- To Hear (Perceive by the ear)

(Hebrew word – *Shama*) Translated In Old Testament

- Hear 785 times
- Hearken 196 times
- Obey 81 times
- Obedient 8 times

(H8085 – Shama) Translated "Hearken"

Genesis 3:17 And unto Adam God said, Because thou hast <u>hearkened</u> (Listened to) unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed *is* the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat *of* it all the days of thy life;

(H8085 – *Shama*) Translated "Hear and Hearken"

Genesis 49:2 Gather yourselves together, and hear, (Listen) ye sons of Jacob; and hearken (Listened to) unto Israel your father.

(H8085 – Shama) Translated "Obedient"

Exodus 24:7 And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD hath said will we do, and be <u>obedient</u> (give heed).

Disobedient



Disobedient– Strong's H4784 (*Marah*) verb

- •To stroke; to stripe; specially to lash with a whip; to rub; to rub over; to pass a razor over the skin
- •To resist; To contend (struggle) against; Striking and contending with both hands.
- •To stroke or strike anyone's mouth, i.e. to refuse to hear his words, to treat him with contempt

(Hebrew word – *Marah*) Translated In Old Testament

- Rebel 19 times
- Rebellious 9 times
- Disobedient 2 times
- Disobeyed 1 time

(H4784 – Marah) Translated "Rebel"

Joshua 1:18 Whosoever he be that doth rebel against thy commandment, and will not hearken H8085 unto thy words in all that thou commandest him, he shall be put to death: only be strong and of a good courage.

(H4784 – Marah) Translated "Rebellious"

Deuteronomy 9:7 Remember, and forget not, how thou provokedst the Lord thy God to wrath in the wilderness: from the day that thou didst depart out of the land of Egypt, until ye came unto this place, ye have been rebellious against the Lord (ye have refused to listen).

Obey – New Testament



Obey – Strong's G5219 (*Hypakouo*) verb

- To Listen, To Hearken
- to obey, be obedient to, submit to

(Greek word – *Hypakouo*) Translated In New Testament

- Obey 18 times
- Be Obedient to − 2 times
- Hearken 1 time

(G5219 – Hypakouo) Translated "Obey"

Matthew 8:27 But the men marveled, saying, What manner of man is this, that even the winds and the sea obey him!

(G5219 – Hypakouo) Translated "Be Obedient to"

Ephesians 6:5 Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ;

(G5219 – Hypakouo) Translated "Hearken"

Acts 12:13 And as Peter knocked at the door of the gate, a damsel came to hearken, named Rhoda.

Disobedient – New Testament



Disobedient – Strong's G545 (*Apeithes*) Adjective

- Impersuasible, Non Compliant
- Contumacious
- Disobedient

(Greek word – *Apeithes*) Translated In New Testament

Disobedient – 6 times

(G545 – Apeithes) Translated "Disobedient"
