

# The Seventh Angel



## 2Thess 2:7-12

- 7-For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. 8-And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: 9-Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, 10-And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; **because they received not the love of the truth**, that they might be saved. 11-And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: 12-That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

**they received not the love of the truth**



- These who receive the Love of the truth will be amongst the warmest and most zealous of God's people. "They are protected in various ways:
- Their love for the Truth is so great that **they would be continually feeding at the table of the Lord. ...**
- **They are so satisfied with the Lord's provision of which they are partaking that they have no appetite for any other food, and they do not seek for it.**

## **Eph. 1:3-5**

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,...

## **Eph 1:18-20**

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,

Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,

*Ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints. Jude 3*

## *The Prophets Spoke for Us*

1Peter 1:10-12

10 - Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you:

11- Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.

12 Unto whom **it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us** they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

## *Seven stages, Seven Angels, Seven Trumpets*

Rev 1:11-17

I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: .., write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches ... I saw seven golden candlesticks; And **in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man**, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

...And **he had in his right hand seven stars**: and out of his mouth went a sharp two edged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.

And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:

*Revelation 10:7*

*But in the days of **the voice of the seventh angel, when he shall begin to sound**, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.*

## *The Trump of God*

*1Thes. 4:15-16;*

*14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so **them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.***

*15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming [Parousia or presence] of the Lord shall not prevent [or precede] them which are asleep.*

*16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and **with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first.***

## *The Trump of God*

*1Corinthians 15:51-52;*

*51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,*

*52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, **[When?] at the last trump [There are only seven trumpets the Last Trumpet being therefore the seventh trump]:** for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead [Sleeping Saints] shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.[one by one the church, they mystery, is to be completed.]*

## *That Servant*

Revelation 3:14, 20;

14 And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write;  
These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness,  
the beginning of the creation of God;

20 Behold, **I stand at the door**, and knock: if any man hear  
my voice, and open the door, **I will come in to him, and will  
sup with him, and he with me.**

## *That Servant*

Luke 12:32, 35,36-37, 41-43

32 Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

35 Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning;

36 And ye yourselves like unto men that wait for their lord, when he will return from the wedding; that when he cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately.

37 Blessed are those servants,[the virgins] whom the lord when he cometh shall find watching: verily I say unto you, that he shall gird himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them.

41 Then Peter said unto him, Lord, speakest thou this parable unto us, or even to all?

42 And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his lord shall make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of meat in due season?

43 Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.



## *Signs of the Lord's Presence*

Matthew 24:44-47

44 Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.

45 Who then is a faithful and wise servant, whom his lord hath made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season?

46 Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing.

47 Verily I say unto you, That he shall make him ruler over all his goods.

## *What messages do we find?*

- Who brought things New and Old from God's storehouse?
- Who announced the Bridegroom's presence?
- Who has shown us from the scriptures that we are living in the time of his presence?
- Who made clear our understanding of the Ransom and Sin-offering?
- Who made clear Consecration, justification, sanctification?
- Who brought to light the time features, blowing the Jubilee trumpet?
- Who announced the reign of Christ and the times of restitution?
- Who explained the Types/Shadows and Anti-types?
- Who announced that it was time for the Harvest work?
- Who pronounced God's judgement upon Babylon?
- Who showed us the bride, the new Jerusalem?
- Etc. etc. The List goes on...

## *Present Truth*

2Peter 1:11,12

11 For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

12 Wherefore I will not be negligent to **put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and be established in the present truth.**

## *Closing*

Rev. 3:18, 20-22;

18 I counsel thee to **buy of me gold tried in the fire**, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, ...

20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and **open the door**, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. 21 **To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne**, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.
