






Pro 4:23




Lev 10:10 and so as to make a distinction between the holy and the profane, and between the unclean and the clean

FOR I AM HOLY."






This transforming of our characters is not instantaneous but gradual






# **My Morning Resolve**

It is the light of God's truth shining in our hearts which shines out upon the world. (2Co 4:6)


Let your light so shine before men. (Mat 5:16)
