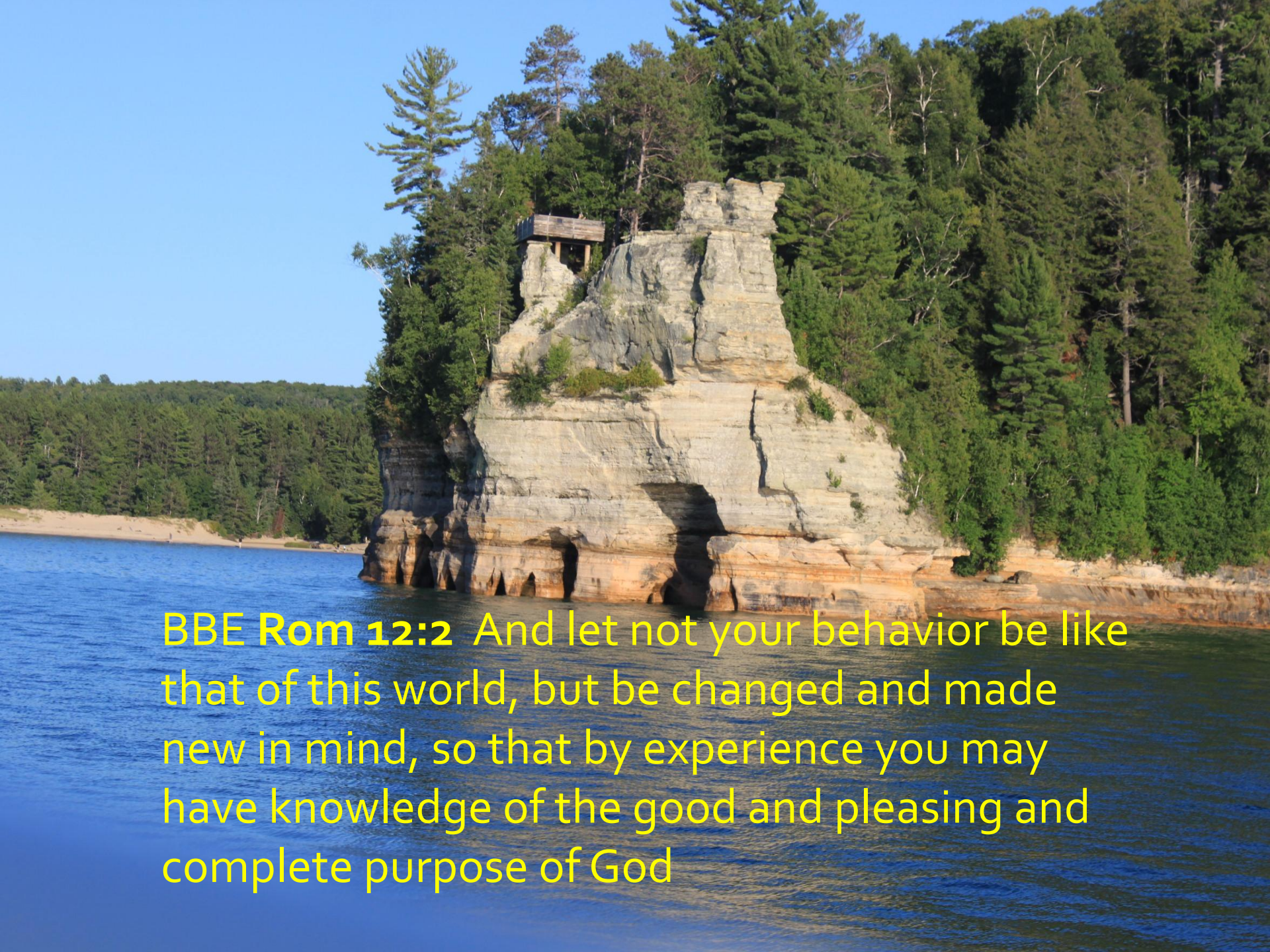




Pro 4:23

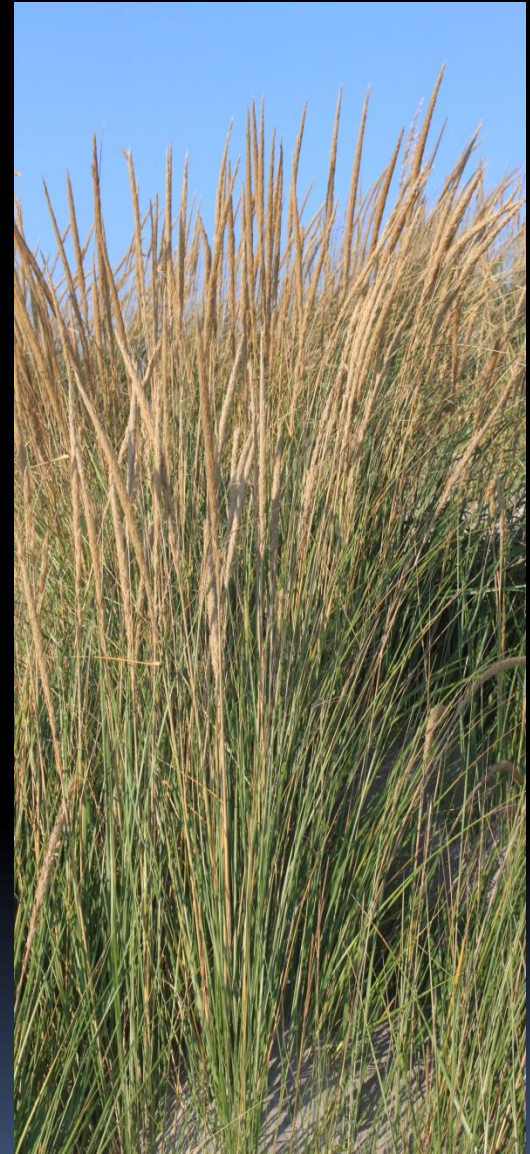



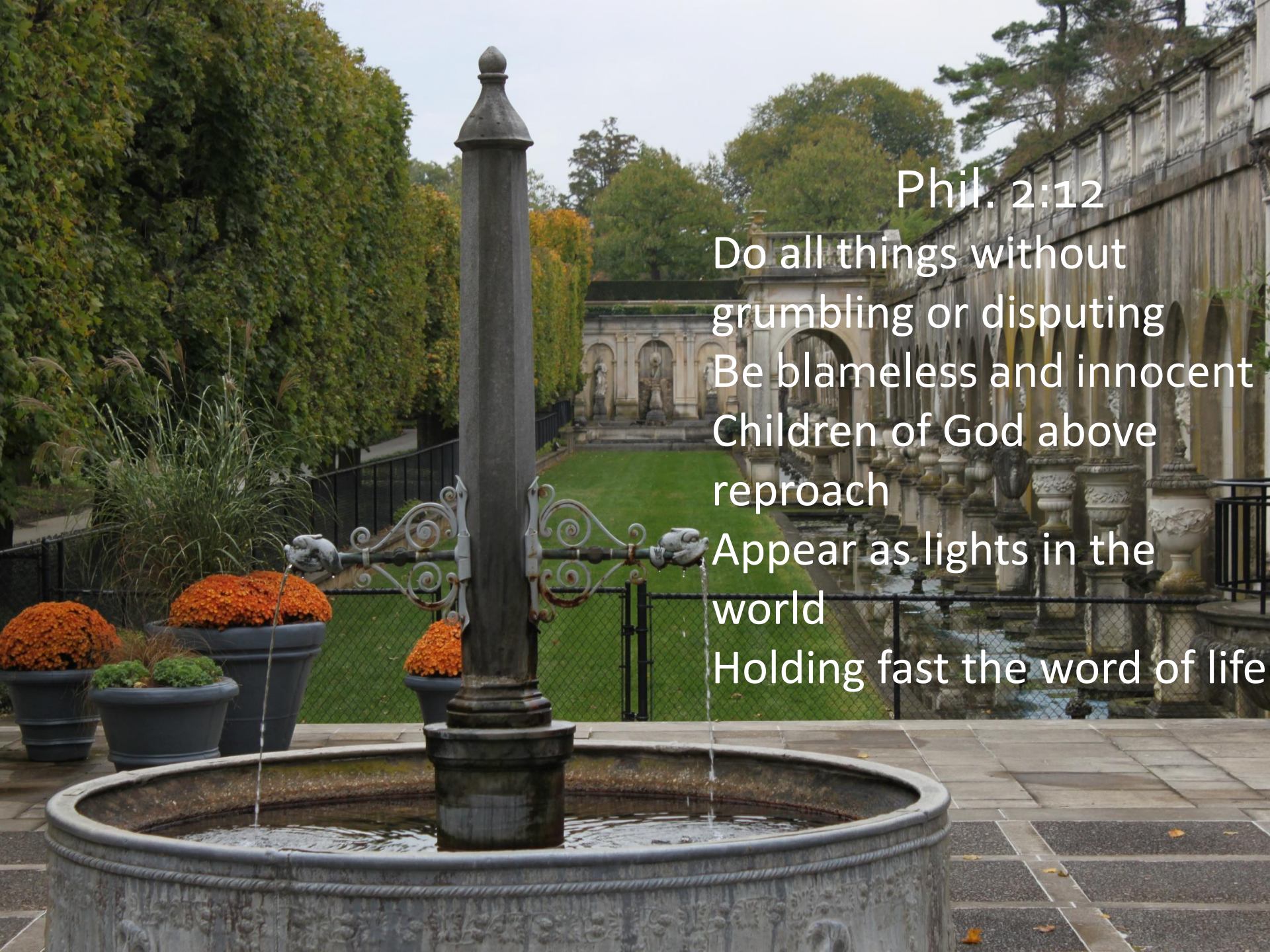


My Morning Resolve
