A few years ago, when I was at the <u>Indianapolis State Fair</u>, I was <u>challenged</u> by some Christian fundamentalists who looked <u>upset</u> with some of the things in our booth. They sternly asked, "<u>What's your message</u>?" I replied with the <u>angels' summary</u> of the <u>Abrahamic Promise</u>...

Luk 2:10 Fear not [God is not a God to be feared]: for, behold [pay attention], I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to <u>all people</u>.

I told them, "The <u>rest</u> of the Bible explains <u>why</u> this statement is true!"

We will be discussing some <u>features</u> of the <u>Abrahamic covenant</u> that <u>make</u> this statement true.

As we know, God promised to make a <u>covenant</u> with Abram upon his <u>entering</u> Canaan, which Abram did at age <u>75</u>.

Gen 12:2 And <u>I will make of thee a great nation</u>, and <u>I will</u> <u>bless thee</u>, and make thy name great; and <u>thou shalt be a</u> <u>blessing</u>: Gen 12:3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and <u>in thee shall all families of the</u> <u>earth be blessed</u>.

God promised several <u>blessings</u> to Abraham's <u>seed</u>.

Gen 12:7 the LORD appeared unto Abram, and said, Unto thy seed will I give this land:

Gen 15:5 ... Look now toward heaven, and <u>tell the stars, if</u> <u>thou be able to number them</u>: ... <u>So shall thy seed be</u>.

After 10 years with no <u>children</u>, no <u>seed</u>, Sarah gave <u>Hagar</u>, her <u>bondwoman</u> or maid, to <u>Abram</u> to father a <u>son</u>, whose name was Ishmael.

But God had told <u>Abraham</u>, that the <u>promised seed</u> would come through <u>Sarah</u>...

Gen 17:19 And God said, <u>Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a</u> <u>son</u> indeed; and thou shalt call his name <u>Isaac</u>: and <u>I will</u> establish my covenant with <u>him</u> for an everlasting covenant, and <u>with his seed after him</u>.

Abraham was <u>100</u> and Sarah <u>90</u>. This was an <u>amazing</u> miracle and <u>proved</u> that <u>nothing</u> was too hard for the Lord.

When Isaac was a man (30), Abraham was told...

Gen 22:2 And he said, <u>Take now thy son</u>, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of <u>Moriah</u>; and <u>offer him there for a burnt offering</u> upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.

Abraham did not falter or murmur but obeyed completely.

Heb 11:19 <u>Accounting</u> that God was able to <u>raise him up</u>, even from the <u>dead</u>; from whence also he received him in a figure. God stopped Abraham, and told him...

Gen 22:16 And said, <u>By myself have I sworn</u>, saith the LORD, for because thou hast <u>done</u> this thing, and hast <u>not</u> <u>withheld thy son</u>, thine only son: Gen 22:17 That <u>in blessing I will bless thee</u>, and in multiplying I will multiply <u>thy seed</u> as the <u>stars of the</u> <u>heaven</u>, and as <u>the sand which is upon the sea shore</u>; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies; Gen 22:18 And <u>in thy seed</u> shall <u>all the nations of the earth</u> be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.

Soon after, <u>Sarah</u> died, and Abraham sent <u>Eliezar</u> to find a <u>bride</u> for Isaac from Paddan-Aram (Haran).

Upon <u>Rebecca's</u> return, Isaac took her into Sarah's <u>tent</u> and she became his wife. (Gen 24:67)

Abraham later took another wife, Keturah, and had six more children.

Paul tells us that the first <u>two wives</u> of Abraham represent <u>two</u> <u>covenants</u>.

(We will talk about the Keturah covenant a little later.)

As <u>Sarah</u> went <u>barren</u> for many years, so the primary <u>seed</u> of the <u>Sarah</u> feature of the Abrahamic covenant went <u>barren</u> for millennia.

<u>Hagar</u> was used to <u>attempt</u> to bring forth the <u>seed of promise</u>, but her <u>child</u> was <u>not</u> what God intended.

Most of Israel either <u>rejected</u> the <u>Law covenant</u> [pictured by Hagar] as <u>undoable</u> or, merely did the <u>letter</u> of the Law. <u>Many</u> did only the things that were <u>convenient</u> for them, things that didn't interfere with their <u>fallen</u> <u>human</u> <u>ambitions</u>. They didn't <u>appreciate</u> the <u>righteousness</u> and <u>beauty</u> in the <u>Law</u>.

God told them...

Psa 50:16 ...What hast <u>thou</u> to do to <u>declare my statutes</u>, or that thou shouldest take <u>my covenant</u> in thy mouth? Psa 50:17 Seeing thou <u>hatest</u> instruction, and <u>castest my</u> <u>words behind thee</u>.

Jesus spoke of their hypocrisy:

Mat 23:23 <u>Woe</u> unto you, scribes and Pharisees, <u>hypocrites</u>! for ye pay <u>tithe</u> of <u>mint</u> and <u>anise</u> and <u>cummin</u>, and have <u>omitted the weightier matters of the Law</u>, <u>judgment</u>, <u>mercy</u>, and <u>faith</u>:

God prophesied of this condition...

Isa 5:1 ... My well-beloved hath a vineyard in a very <u>fruitful</u> <u>hill</u>:

Isa 5:2 And he <u>fenced it</u> [with the Law], and gathered out the stones [difficulties] thereof, and <u>planted</u> it with the <u>choicest vine</u> [the Abrahamic promise], and built a <u>tower</u> in the midst of it [the oversight of the prophets], and also made a <u>winepress</u> therein [to gather <u>righteous fruitage</u>]: and he looked that it should bring forth <u>grapes</u>, and <u>it</u> brought forth <u>wild grapes</u>. [poison berries].

As a result...

Isa 5:6 ... I will lay it <u>waste</u>... I will also command the clouds that they <u>rain no rain upon it</u>.

Isa 5:7 For the <u>vineyard</u> of the <u>LORD</u> of hosts is the <u>house</u> <u>of Israel</u>,

The <u>Law Covenant</u> was 430 years after the Abrahamic Covenant (Gen 12:3), but it could <u>not</u> bring forth the <u>seed of promise</u>.

The <u>Sarah covenant</u> was the covenant of <u>grace</u>, of <u>faith</u>. This <u>original</u> Abrahamic covenant <u>could</u> bring forth the <u>promised</u> <u>seed</u>, in God's due time.

Gal 4:4 But when the <u>fullness of the time was come</u>, God sent forth his <u>Son</u>, made of a <u>woman</u>, made <u>under the law</u>, Gal 4:5 To <u>redeem</u> them that were <u>under the law</u>, that we might receive the adoption of <u>sons</u>.

Being born <u>under</u> the Law, Jesus was <u>obligated</u> to <u>keep</u> the Law.

His <u>keeping</u> the Law proved that the was the <u>perfect man</u>, <u>entitled</u> to human <u>life</u>, forever.

Lev 18:5 Ye shall therefore <u>keep</u> my statutes, and my judgments: which if a man <u>do</u>, he shall <u>live</u>

But at <u>30 years of age</u>, he laid down his <u>human life</u> in sacrifice to do God's will. He became a <u>divine new creature</u> to be developed under the <u>Sarah feature</u> of the <u>Abrahamic covenant</u>.

At his <u>death</u>, the <u>ransom-price</u> for Adam, the <u>value</u> of his sacrificed <u>human life</u>, was still <u>his</u>.

Joh 10:18 No man taketh [my life] from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to <u>lay it down</u>, and I have power to <u>take it again</u>.

He would now use it to justify his body members who would follow him in the same path, and in the same covenant of sacrifice as shown in Lev 8:14-35.

Though the Law covenant <u>failed</u> to bring forth the <u>promised</u> <u>seed</u>, especially among fallen Israel, it <u>failed</u> with <u>great success</u> <u>because</u> the Law showed Israel, and <u>especially</u> the <u>Israelites</u> <u>indeed</u> what <u>true righteousness is</u>. Those who could <u>see</u> the <u>spirit</u> of the Law, dearly <u>appreciated</u> it.

As David said,

Psa 119:97 O how <u>love</u> I thy Law! it is my meditation all the day. Psa 119:112 I have inclined mine <u>heart</u> to perform thy statutes <u>always</u>, even unto the end. <u>David</u> could look <u>forward</u> to a world where <u>all mankind loved</u> and <u>kept</u> these righteous laws, and loved the <u>True God</u> who <u>gave</u> these laws for the <u>blessing</u> of <u>mankind</u>.

As Paul said...

Gal 3:24 Wherefore the <u>Law</u> was our <u>schoolmaster</u> to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by faith.

The <u>Israelites indeed</u> could see the <u>divine standard</u> of the <u>Law</u> <u>and</u> <u>Jesus</u>, the anointed of God, who was <u>keeping</u> it.

On the day of <u>Pentecost</u> Peter spoke to <u>all</u> the House of Israel...

Act 2:36 ... that <u>God</u> hath made that same <u>Jesus</u>, whom ye have crucified, both <u>Lord</u> and <u>Christ</u>.

They were pricked in their hearts. Peter told them

Act 2:38 ...<u>Repent</u>, and be <u>baptized</u> every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.

Spoken by the Prophet Joel

Joe 2:29 ... upon the <u>servants</u> and upon the <u>handmaids</u> in those days will I <u>pour out my spirit</u>.

These were the <u>Israelites indeed</u>, the fully consecrated ones who transferred from Moses to Christ...

#### F434

To every "Israelite indeed," already thus consecrated and bound to Moses even unto death, and with all their hopes of life anchored in him, it was but <u>a small remove to accept</u> <u>Christ in his stead</u>, and as his <u>antitype</u>; and to understand that their <u>pledges under the Law to Moses</u> were <u>now</u> <u>transferred by divine arrangement to Christ</u>, the surety of the New Covenant which they engaged to serve.

After <u>36 AD</u>, the <u>opportunity</u> was opened wide to both <u>Jews</u> and <u>Gentiles</u> to come into <u>Christ</u> through <u>faith</u> in the <u>blood of Christ</u>, which will bring them to the Father with <u>imputed justification</u> for making an acceptable <u>consecration</u>, to become <u>Jesus body</u> <u>members</u>.

<u>These</u> are also developed under the <u>Sarah feature</u> of the <u>Abrahamic covenant</u>, according to their <u>faith</u>.

They are <u>not</u> judged according to the <u>letter</u> of the Law, which they <u>cannot</u> do, but as Paul tells us:

Rom 8:4 That the <u>righteousness</u> of the Law might be <u>fulfilled</u> in <u>us</u>, who walk <u>not</u> after the flesh, but after the <u>Spirit</u>.

These appreciate the <u>spirit</u> of <u>righteousness</u>, and <u>desire</u> to <u>mortify</u> the deeds of the flesh in their human vessels.

Rom 8:13 ... if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

God tells his children...

Pro 23:26 My son, give me thine <u>heart</u>, and let thine eyes observe my ways.

Paul speaks of the seed of Abraham in Galatians

Gal 3:16 - Now to Abraham and his <u>seed</u> were the promises made. He saith not, and to <u>seeds</u>, as of <u>many</u>; but as of <u>one</u>, and to thy seed, <u>which is Christ</u>.

But <u>Christ</u> is the <u>head and body</u>...

Gal 3:29 - And if ye be <u>Christ's</u>, then are ye Abraham's <u>seed</u>, and heirs according to the promise.

So <u>we</u> are part of this <u>seed</u> of Abraham which will bless <u>all</u> the families of the earth.

The <u>Christ</u> head and body are the <u>Stars of Heaven</u> class of <u>144,001</u> divine beings who will have the <u>privilege</u> to bless all the families of the earth.

Isa 2:3 For the Law will go forth from <u>Zion</u>, And the word of the LORD from <u>Jerusalem</u>.

This speaks of the <u>Two Phases</u> of the <u>Kingdom</u>.

The <u>heavenly phase</u>, here called <u>Zion</u>, is made up <u>exclusively</u> of the Christ <u>head</u> and <u>body</u>.

Although there will be <u>other</u> spirit beings <u>associated</u> with the Heavenly Kingdom, they will not be <u>in</u> the Kingdom.

# R2052

The "great company" do **not** belong to the Kingdom **at all**. They will be associated in some way not explained, but will not be part of the Kingdom real, nor yet of the earthly or representative Kingdom.

Only those who were <u>faithful</u> in their part of the <u>sin-offering</u>, the <u>"little flock</u>" will be in the <u>heavenly phase</u> of the Kingdom.

### SM 680

"Fear not, <u>little flock</u>; for it is your Father's good pleasure to <u>give</u> you the Kingdom," said the Master. (Luk 12:32.) <u>Only</u> <u>the Royal Family</u> will get the Kingdom."

"All others will be the subjects of the Kingdom."

We'd now like to look at the <u>Earthly Phase</u> of the kingdom and look at its <u>work</u> as it <u>progresses</u> to <u>achieve</u> the <u>final</u> result of blessing <u>all</u> the families of the earth.

Looking back at the <u>Sarah</u> [faith] feature of the Abrahamic Covenant, we can see that there <u>were</u> in fact <u>children</u> of this covenant <u>before</u> the spiritual seed was <u>developed</u>.

Paul tells us of these in Heb 11 – the Ancient Worthies.

Heb 11:1 Now <u>faith</u> is the <u>substance</u> of things hoped for, the <u>evidence</u> of things not seen. Heb 11:2 For by it [faith] the <u>elders</u> obtained a <u>good report</u>.

By faith, by faith, etc.

Heb 11:13 <u>These all died in faith</u>, not having <u>received</u> the promises, but having <u>seen them afar off</u>, and were <u>persuaded</u> of them, and <u>embraced</u> them, and <u>confessed</u> that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

Heb 11:39 And these all, <u>having obtained a good report</u> through <u>faith</u>, received not the promise [the <u>earthly</u> <u>promises</u>]:

Heb 11:40 God having provided some better thing for us, that <u>they</u> without us should not be made <u>perfect</u>.

Some of these <u>Ancient Worthies</u> lived <u>before</u> the <u>Law</u> Covenant and even before <u>Abraham</u>. They received their "<u>Good Report</u>" and "<u>pleased God</u>" by their <u>faith</u> – shown by their <u>trust</u>.

It is interesting that the word "<u>Faith</u>" appears in the Old Testament only <u>twice</u>. But the word <u>trust</u> appears <u>107 times</u>.

**H2620** - to flee for <u>protection</u>; to <u>confide</u> in: - have <u>hope</u>, make <u>refuge</u>, (put) <u>trust</u>.

**H982** - to <u>trust</u>, be <u>confident</u> or <u>sure</u>: - be <u>bold</u>, <u>careless</u> (Free from care or anxiety)

This "<u>fleeing for protection</u>" should <u>not</u> be confused with "<u>fear</u>" as a person may look for <u>any</u> port in a <u>storm</u>. Instead, these sought <u>protection</u> in the <u>one true God</u>, in whom they had <u>full</u> <u>confidence</u> and <u>trust</u>, <u>come what may</u>.

As <u>Job</u> said,

Job 13:15 Though he <u>slay</u> me, yet will I <u>trust in him</u>:

This faith was expressed in their actions and trust in God.

As in the "<u>Three Hebrews</u>" (Hananiah, Azariah, Mishael) who said – "

Dan 3:17-18 ...our <u>God</u> whom we <u>serve</u> is <u>able</u> to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace... <u>but if not</u>, We will <u>not</u> serve thy gods.

These <u>Ancient Worthies</u> were under the <u>Sarah</u> or <u>Faith</u> covenant, rather than the <u>Law</u> covenant

# **R4330 – ANCIENT WORTHIES UNDER FAITH COVENANT**

"a <u>few</u> individuals of that nation, <u>rising</u> by their <u>faith superior</u> to that [Law] <u>Covenant</u>, trusted <u>not</u> to <u>it</u>, but to the <u>original</u> <u>Covenant of Mercy</u>, <u>Grace</u>--the <u>Sarah</u> Covenant. These are the <u>Ancient Worthies</u> mentioned by the Apostle."

According to their **works** they were <u>condemned by the Law</u> <u>Covenant</u>, but <u>according to their **faith**</u> they were <u>acceptable</u> <u>to God</u>, along the lines of the <u>Sarah Covenant</u>, even though they could not <u>receive</u> their blessing under it, until <u>first the</u> <u>promised Seed</u> should come and <u>the blood of that</u> <u>Covenant be shed</u>.

The <u>Gospel Church</u> **and** the <u>Ancient Worthies</u> have <u>not</u> been <u>judged</u> according to their **works**, but according to their <u>faith</u>--works having been demanded to the extent of <u>ability</u>, as <u>attesting faith</u>.

<u>Thus</u> we see that the <u>influence</u> of the <u>original</u> [Sarah] <u>Covenant</u>, <u>after</u> electing a <u>Faith Seed</u>, both <u>natural</u> and <u>spiritual</u>, will, <u>through these</u> by the <u>New</u> (Law) Covenant, bless a far greater number than by any other method conceivable.

#### Two Bands of God's heroes

<u>Ancient</u> Worthies and the <u>Christian</u> Worthies – the same class at <u>heart</u> – but with different <u>opportunities</u>.

Both developed under the <u>Sarah covenant</u> – the <u>Faith</u> <u>Covenant</u> – the <u>Faith Seed</u>

Br Russell teaches about the two phases of the Kingdom in

# A288-292

"the Kingdom of God will be of <u>two parts</u>, a spiritual or <u>heavenly phase</u> and an earthly or <u>human phase</u>. ... its presence and power will be mightily <u>manifested</u>, chiefly through its <u>human representatives</u>, who will constitute the <u>earthly phase</u> of the Kingdom of God." "And <u>those</u> so highly honored as to have a <u>share</u> in it will be the most exalted and honored of God among <u>men</u>. These are the class ...<u>whose judgment day was previous</u> to the Gospel age."

"Having been tried and found faithful, in the awakening they ...will at once receive the <u>reward</u> of their faithfulness--an <u>instantaneous resurrection to perfection as men</u>."

"And that these <u>Ancient Worthies will be in the human</u> <u>phase of the kingdom</u> and <u>seen</u> of mankind is fully <u>attested</u> <u>by Jesus'</u> words to the unbelieving Jews who were rejecting him. He said, "Ye shall <u>see Abraham</u>, <u>Isaac</u>, and <u>Jacob</u>, and all the prophets, <u>in the Kingdom of God</u>." [Luk 13:28-29]"

"It is through these <u>two phases</u> of the kingdom that the promise to Abraham is to be <u>verified</u> ..."Thy seed shall be as <u>the sand of the sea</u>, and as <u>the stars of heaven</u>"-- an <u>earthly</u> and a <u>heavenly</u> seed, both God's instruments of blessing to the world."

"This <u>proves</u> the double fulfilment of the promise in the development of the <u>two seeds</u>, <u>earthly</u> (human) and <u>heavenly</u> (spiritual), which will <u>constitute</u> the <u>two phases</u> of <u>the kingdom</u>."

These will also be part of the Royal Family...

Psa 45:16 Instead of thy fathers shall be thy <u>children</u>, whom thou mayest make <u>princes</u> in all the earth.

Natural Israel <u>cannot</u> <u>initially</u> be part of this <u>earthly seed of</u> <u>Abraham</u>. They will <u>still</u> be an <u>unrighteous</u>, <u>ungodly</u> class at the beginning of the Mediatorial Kingdom and must first be cleansed...

"While <u>Israelites</u> in various stages of unbelief will be gathered back to Palestine under divine favor, according to promise, yet <u>none</u> shall be in any degree reckoned as a <u>part</u>, or even as <u>supporters</u> of, or <u>associated</u> with the <u>earthly phase of the Kingdom</u>, <u>except</u> as they shall <u>first</u> <u>recognize Christ Jesus</u> as the <u>Son of God</u>, the only <u>Redeemer</u> and <u>Deliverer</u> for <u>Israel</u> and the <u>world</u>."

"The <u>beginning</u> of the <u>earthly phase of the Kingdom</u> ...will, we understand, <u>consist wholly</u> of the resurrected <u>holy ones</u> <u>of olden time</u>--from John the Baptizer back to Abel--"Abraham, Isaac, Jacob and all the holy prophets."

As Paul said of this work...

Rom 11:26 And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and <u>shall turn</u> <u>away ungodliness from Jacob</u>

Jacob, Israel, will need <u>cleansing</u> and <u>teaching</u> and to be given a "new <u>heart</u> and <u>spirit</u>".

The <u>Red Heifer</u> is a picture of <u>what</u> the Ancient Worthies <u>did</u> in the <u>past</u> and what they will <u>do</u> in the <u>future</u>.

### T110p1

"In that the red heifer never wore a <u>yoke</u>, [Num 19:2,Gal 5:1] it represented a class of <u>justified</u> persons--made <u>free</u> from the <u>Law Covenant</u>."

God justified them through faith as children of faithful Abraham.

The heifer was <u>red</u> – showing that the Ancient Worthies were <u>not sinless</u>.

The heifer was <u>burned</u> - picturing the <u>ignominy</u> heaped upon them by <u>Israel</u> and the <u>world</u>.

Three things cast into the burning heifer

Num 19:6 And the priest shall take <u>cedar wood</u>, and <u>hyssop</u>, and <u>scarlet</u>, and cast it into the midst of the burning of the heifer.

"The <u>casting</u> of these three into the midst of the burning would imply that... the <u>merit</u> of the precious <u>blood</u>, the <u>cleansing</u> of the <u>truth</u>, and the gift of <u>everlasting life</u> to be <u>accounted to them through faith</u>; and that <u>subsequent to</u> <u>their death</u> they would be recognized as <u>cleansed</u>, justified, <u>accepted</u>." <u>When</u> would this be? – not when they are <u>dead</u>, but at their <u>resurrection</u>!

The future job of the Ancient Worthies (Red Heifer) is to clean up others... Here is <u>how</u> and <u>when</u>

Note carefully that the <u>unclean</u> do <u>not</u> apply the <u>ashes</u> of the red heifer to <u>themselves</u>.

The <u>clean</u> person must cleanse the <u>unclean</u>.

And initially, the <u>only</u> clean persons will be the <u>Ancient</u> <u>Worthies</u>. The "<u>Just men made perfect</u>." (Heb 12:23)

Num 19:18 And a <u>clean person shall take hyssop</u>, and dip it in the <u>water</u>, and sprinkle it upon the <u>tent</u>, and upon all the <u>vessels</u>, and <u>upon the persons</u> that were there, and upon him that touched a <u>bone</u>, or one slain, or one <u>dead</u>, or a <u>grave</u>: Num 19:19 And the <u>clean person shall sprinkle upon the</u> <u>unclean</u> on the <u>third</u> day, and on the <u>seventh day</u>

The <u>cleansing</u> was for those who had contact with <u>death</u>. This pictures the <u>defilements</u> of Adamic <u>death</u> from the <u>fall</u>. <u>Selfishness</u>, <u>pride</u>, <u>hatred</u>, <u>envy</u>, etc.

"<u>All</u> the blemishes of the <u>fallen condition</u> are so much of contact with <u>death</u>; all constitutional <u>weaknesses</u> and <u>blemishes</u> through heredity are <u>contacts with death</u> and from <u>all of these</u> the <u>ashes</u> of the Red Heifer are to be used for the cleansing of <u>all</u> who will <u>become</u> the people of God."

"Each pardoned sinner, <u>desiring</u> to be cleansed <u>perfectly</u>, must not only wash himself with <u>water (truth)</u>, but must also have applied to him the <u>instructions</u> of these "<u>princes</u>."

The <u>Ancient Worthies</u>, this <u>Red Heifer class</u>, this <u>Faith Seed</u>, developed under the <u>Sarah</u> Covenant, will work with <u>natural</u> <u>Israel</u> to cleanse <u>them</u> from their Adamic defilements of <u>sin</u>, <u>pride</u>, <u>unbelief</u>, and <u>ungodliness</u>.

Eze 36:24 For I will <u>take you from among the heathen</u>, and <u>gather you out of all countries</u>, and will bring you into your <u>own land</u>.

Eze 36:25 <u>Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you</u>, and ye shall be <u>clean</u>: from all your <u>filthiness</u>, and from all your <u>idols</u>, will I <u>cleanse</u> you. (Cleansing of the Red Heffer.)

Eze 36:26 A <u>new heart</u> also will I give you, and a <u>new spirit</u> will I put within you: and I will <u>take away the stony heart</u> out of your flesh, and I will give you a <u>heart of flesh</u>.

Eze 36:27 And I will put <u>my spirit within you</u>, and cause you to <u>walk in my statutes</u>, and ye shall <u>keep my</u> judgments, and <u>do</u> them.

John the Baptist was the Last of the Ancient Worthies and will completely verify who Jesus was...

Joh 1:36 ...<u>looking upon Jesus</u> he saith, <u>Behold the Lamb</u> of God!

The process of taking <u>out</u> the <u>stony heart</u> includes their <u>acknowledgment</u> who <u>Jesus</u> <u>truly</u> was. The Ancient Worthies provide this evidence.

As Jesus had told them...

Luk 13:28 There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see <u>Abraham</u>, and <u>Isaac</u>, and <u>Jacob</u>, and all the prophets [the <u>Ancient Worthies</u>], in the <u>[earthly phase]</u> kingdom of God, and <u>you yourselves thrust out</u>.

This prejudice of their stony hearts was spoken of by Paul:

2Co 3:13 And **not** as <u>Moses</u>, which put a <u>veil</u> over <u>his</u> face, that the children of Israel could not steadfastly look to the end of that which is abolished:

Paul is saying that this prejudice was/is due to their own pride and stubbornness.

2Co 3:14 But their <u>minds</u> were <u>blinded</u>: for until this day remaineth the same veil <u>untaken away</u> in the reading of the <u>old testament</u>; which <u>veil</u> is <u>done away</u> in Christ. 2Co 3:15 But even unto this day, when <u>Moses</u> is read, the <u>veil</u> is upon their <u>heart</u>. 2Co 3:16 Nevertheless when it shall turn to the <u>Lord</u>, the

veil shall be taken away.

Jesus had spoken of their prejudice and unbelief regarding himself...

Joh 5:39 Search the <u>Scriptures</u>; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and <u>they</u> are <u>they</u> which testify of <u>me</u>. Joh 5:46 For had ye <u>believed</u> Moses, ye would have <u>believed</u> me: for he <u>wrote</u> of <u>me</u>.

Jessus also said to them...

Luk 13:35 ... Ye shall not <u>see</u> me [<u>understand</u> who I am in God's plan], until the time come when ye shall <u>say</u>, <u>Blessed</u> is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.

This <u>understanding</u> will be <u>brought</u> to <u>Israel</u> by the <u>Earthly</u> <u>Phase of the Kingdom</u> – the Ancient Worthies

Then they will say in that day...

Isa 25:9 <u>Lo, this is our God; we have waited for him</u>, and he will save us: this is the LORD; we have waited for him, we will be glad and rejoice in his salvation.

They will <u>see</u> the <u>Ancient Worthies</u> as the <u>earthly</u> <u>representatives</u> of the <u>Heavenly Kingdom</u> (Zion).

They will see these <u>Ancient Worthies</u> as the <u>intended</u> "<u>Veil</u>" on <u>Moses face</u> when he came down the second time with the Law in Exo 34.

Exo 34:29 ... when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of testimony ...he knew not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with him.

Moses "<u>put a veil on his face</u>" so that he could communicate with the people. (Exo 34:33)

"And the veil which Moses afterward <u>wore</u> before the <u>people</u>, but laid off when with the Lord in the Mount would seem to typify the <u>earthly phase of his Kingdom</u>, the "<u>princes in all the earth</u>" through whom the Christ will speak to the people and be represented, the glory being <u>hidden</u>."

Gradually their <u>stony hearts</u> will be removed. They will be given a <u>new spirit</u> – "ruach" – <u>influence</u> of the holy spirit –

Zec 12:10 And I will <u>pour upon</u> the house of <u>David</u>, and upon the inhabitants of <u>Jerusalem</u>, the spirit of <u>grace</u> and of <u>supplications</u> [prayer]: and they shall look upon <u>me</u> whom they have <u>pierced</u>, and they shall mourn for <u>him</u>, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn.

Then they will be "given" a heart of flesh...

Eze 36:26 A <u>new heart</u> also will I give you, and a new <u>spirit</u> will I put within you: and I will <u>take away the stony heart</u> out of your flesh, and I will give you a <u>heart of flesh</u>.

Their <u>hearts</u> – their <u>desires</u> will no longer be to do their <u>own</u> wills, but to do <u>God's</u> will and to <u>bless</u> others.

Eze 36:27 And I will put <u>my spirit within you</u>, and cause you to <u>walk in my statutes</u>, and ye shall <u>keep my</u> judgments, and <u>do</u> them.

This work of the <u>Ancient Worthies</u> as intermediaries between natural Israel and the Christ head and body is also shown in Jacob's ladder.

Gen 28:12 And he dreamed, and behold a <u>ladder set up</u> on the earth, and the top of it <u>reached to heaven</u>: and behold the <u>angels of God ascending and descending on it</u>.

#### D629

This seems to be the <u>intimation</u> of our <u>Lord's words</u> to <u>Nathanael</u>:

Joh 1:51 "Hereafter ye shall see <u>heaven opened</u>, and the <u>angels</u> of God [<u>the messengers of God</u>, <u>the "princes" of the</u> <u>new dispensation</u>] ascending to and descending <u>from</u> the Son of Man."

This will provide the proper <u>influence</u> which will <u>motivate</u> <u>natural</u> <u>Israel</u> to be <u>fully cleansed</u> and to <u>want</u> the <u>full blessing</u> that God <u>intends</u> for them.

Later, <u>Jacob</u>, after serving <u>Laban</u> for decades, was <u>retuning</u> to the promised land. Jacob had <u>already seen</u> the fulfillment of God's earlier <u>promise</u> of protection...

Gen 28:15 And, behold, <u>I am with thee</u>, and will keep thee in all places whither thou goest, and will <u>bring thee again</u> <u>into this land</u>; for I will not leave thee, until I have done <u>that</u> <u>which I have spoken</u> to thee of.

So, as the <u>children</u> of Israel were <u>scattered</u> throughout the <u>world</u>, they were actually <u>kept</u> by God so that they could <u>return</u> to their land and <u>see</u> the blessings that God had for <u>them</u>.

Just as Jacob was about to the enter the land...

Jacob <u>wrestled</u> with a <u>man</u> [really an <u>angel</u> of God] until the <u>breaking of the day</u>. The man said...

Gen 32:26 ... Let me go, for the day breaketh. And Jacob said, I will <u>not</u> let thee go, except thou <u>bless</u> me.

Israel will then earnestly <u>desire</u> the kingdom blessings...

#### R3970

Representing the Jewish people when the Lord shall shortly "pour out upon them the spirit of prayer and supplication."

And the man [angel] said...

Gen 32:28 And he said, Thy name shall be called no more <u>Jacob [supplanter]</u>, but <u>Israel</u>: for as a <u>prince</u> hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed.

This seems to show that after <u>desiring</u> and <u>working</u> for the blessings of the Kingdom, <u>Jacob</u> [<u>natural Israel</u>] will <u>truly</u> become the <u>**Princely** Natural Israel</u> that <u>God</u> <u>intends</u> for them.

They were <u>initially</u> developed under the <u>Law Covenant</u>, the <u>Hagar</u> covenant of bondage to the <u>Law</u>, that they could <u>not</u> do, with a <u>mediator</u> who was himself condemned.

But <u>now</u>, under the <u>Keturah</u> Covenant - the <u>New Law Covenant</u> – with a <u>divine mediator</u> of the <u>Christ</u> head and body, and with the Ancient Worthies, the...

"Just men made perfect", the "princes in all the earth," ...natural Israel will **also** become the Blesser Seed – the sand upon the sea shore class in the Abrahamic promise of Gen 22:17.

The New Covenant will be made with Israel...

Jer 31:31 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a <u>new covenant with the house of Israel</u>, and with the <u>house of Judah</u>:

Jer 31:33 <u>I will put my Law in their inward parts</u>, and <u>write</u> <u>it in their hearts</u>; and will <u>be their God</u>, and <u>they shall be my</u> <u>people</u>.

This will be seen by <u>all</u> mankind.

Mic 4:2 And <u>many nations</u> shall come, and say, Come, and let <u>us</u> go up to the mountain of the LORD, and to the <u>house</u> of the God of <u>Jacob</u>; and he will <u>teach</u> us of his ways, and we will <u>walk</u> in his paths: for the <u>Law</u> shall go forth of <u>Zion</u>, and the word of the LORD from <u>Jerusalem</u>.

The <u>blessings</u> will flow <u>through</u> Israel to everyone who ever lived...

Isa 42:6 I the LORD have called <u>thee</u> in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give <u>thee</u> for a <u>covenant</u> of the <u>people</u>, for a <u>light</u> of the <u>Gentiles</u>; Isa 42:7 To <u>open</u> the <u>blind eyes</u>, to bring out the <u>prisoners</u> from the <u>prison</u>, and them that <u>sit</u> in <u>darkness</u> out of the <u>prison house</u>.

R2504 – <u>All mankind</u> will become the seed of Abraham

"Indeed, <u>all mankind</u> then coming into <u>harmony</u> with the Kingdom will be counted as <u>Israelites</u>--<u>children</u> of the true <u>Israel of God</u>--<u>Christ</u>. All such will be counted as "<u>children</u> <u>of Abraham</u>," who as a type of God is the "father of the faithful" with one <u>Seed</u> (the <u>heavenly</u>, Christ and the Church) as the <u>stars of heaven</u>, and another (<u>faithful</u> fleshly <u>Israelites</u> from <u>all peoples</u>, <u>kindreds</u> and <u>tongues</u>) as the <u>sand by the sea-shore</u>.--`Gen\_22:17`."

All who will, will be fully reconciled with God...

Rev 21:3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, <u>Behold</u>, the tabernacle of <u>God</u> is with <u>men</u>, and <u>he will</u> <u>dwell with them</u>, and <u>they shall be his people</u>, and <u>God</u> <u>himself shall be with them</u>, <u>and be their God</u>.

And finally...

Num 14:21 But as truly as I live, <u>all the earth</u> shall be <u>filled</u> with the <u>glory of the LORD</u>.

So, the statement of the angels to the shepherds is true!

Luk 2:10 ... Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to <u>all</u> people!
