Additional Precious Promises (not in EGPP booklet)

(Psa 1:1 KJV) Blessed *is* the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.

(Psa 1:2 KJV) ... his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

Psa 1:6 GNB The righteous are guided and protected by the LORD...

(Psa 3:3 KJV) But thou, O LORD, art a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.

(Psa 3:5 GW) I lie down and sleep. I wake up again because the LORD continues to support me.

(*Psa* 4:7,8) Thou hast put gladness in my heart, more than in the time *that* their corn and their wine increased. I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for thou, LORD, only makest me dwell in safety.

(18) Jehovah hath chastened me sore; But he hath not given me over unto death. (19) Open to me the gates of righteousness: I will enter into them, I will give thanks unto Jehovah. (20) This is the gate of Jehovah; The righteous shall enter into it. (21) I will give thanks unto thee; for thou hast answered me. And art become my salvation. (22) The stone which the builders rejected Is become the head of the corner. (23) This is Jehovah's doing; It is marvellous in our eyes. (24) This is the day which Jehovah hath made; We will rejoice and be glad in it. (25) Save now, we beseech thee, O Jehovah: O Jehovah, we beseech thee, send now prosperity. (26) Blessed be he that cometh in the name of Jehovah: We have blessed you out of the house of Jehovah. (27) Jehovah is God, and he hath given us light: Bind the sacrifice with cords, even unto the horns of the altar. (28) Thou art my God, and I will give thanks unto thee: Thou art my God, I will exalt thee. (29) Oh give thanks unto Jehovah; for he is good; For his lovingkindness endureth for ever.

Psa 121:4 Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep.

Psa 124:8 KJV Our help is in the name of the LORD, who made heaven and earth. Psa 126:3 The LORD hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad. Psa 130:3-6 KJV If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand? (4) But there is forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared. (5) I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope. (6) My soul waiteth for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning: I say, more than they that watch for the morning.

Psa 132:4-5, 13-14 I will not give sleep to mine eyes, *or* slumber to mine eyelids, (5) Until I find out a place for the LORD, an habitation for the mighty *God* of Jacob.(13) For the LORD hath

chosen Zion; he hath desired *it* for his habitation. (14) "This *is* my rest for ever: here will I dwell; for I have desired it".

Psa 133:1-3 Behold, how good and how pleasant *it is* for brethren to dwell together in unity! (2) *It is* like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, *even* Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments; (3) As the dew of Hermon, *and as the dew* that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, *even* life for evermore.

Psa 136:1, 23-24 ASV Oh give thanks unto Jehovah; for he is good; For his lovingkindness endureth for ever(23)Who remembered us in our low estate; For his lovingkindness endureth for ever (24)And hath delivered us from our adversaries; For his lovingkindness endureth for ever

Psa 138:6 Though the LORD be high, yet hath he respect unto the lowly...

Psa 138:7 ASV Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me; Thou wilt stretch forth thy hand against the wrath of mine enemies, And thy right hand will save me.

Psa 139:1 O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known me.

Psa 139:17-18 KJV How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them! (18) If I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.

Psa 139:23-24 ASV Search me, O God, and know my heart: Try me, and know my thoughts; (24) And see if there be any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.

Psa 140:7 CEV You have the power to save me, and you keep me safe in every battle.

Psa 141:2 CEV Think of my prayer as sweet-smelling incense, and think of my lifted hands as an evening sacrifice.

Psa 141:3 Set a watch, O LORD, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips.

Psa 142:3-7 MKJV When my spirit fainted within me, then You knew my path...

Psa 143:8 KJV Cause me to hear thy lovingkindness in the morning; for in thee do I trust: cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee.

Psa 143:10 KJV Teach me to do thy will; for thou art my God: thy spirit is good; lead me into the land of uprightness.

Psa 144:1-2 ASV Blessed be Jehovah my rock, Who teacheth my hands to war, *And* my fingers to fight: (2) My lovingkindness, and my fortress, My high tower, and my deliverer; My shield, and he in whom I take refuge...

Psa 145:8 ASV Jehovah is gracious, and merciful; Slow to anger, and of great lovingkindness

Psa 145:14 ESV The LORD upholds all who are falling and raises up all who are bowed down.

Psa 145:15 The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season.

Psa 146:5 KJV Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God:

Psa 146:8 KJV The LORD openeth the eyes of the blind: the LORD raiseth them that are bowed down: the LORD loveth the righteous

Psa 147:3 He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.

Psa 147:6 ESV The LORD lifts up the humble...

Psa 147:11 ASV Jehovah taketh pleasure in them that fear him, In those that hope

in his lovingkindness.

Psa 147:14 He maketh peace in thy borders, and filleth thee with the finest of the wheat.

Psa 147:19 KJV He sheweth his word unto Jacob, his statutes and his judgments unto Israel.

Psa 149:4 JPS For the LORD taketh pleasure in His people; He adorneth the humble with salvation.

Lam 3:19-23 ASV Remember mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall. (20) My soul hath them still in remembrance, and is bowed down within me. (21) This I recall to my mind; therefore have I hope. (22) *It is of* Jehovah's lovingkindnesses that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. (23) They are new every morning; great is thy faithfulness.

Isa 53:1-12 KJV Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? (2) For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. (3) He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. (4) Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. (5) But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. (6) All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all. (7) He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. (8) He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken. (9) And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. (10) Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand. (11) He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities. (12) Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death; and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

Eph 1:3 KJV Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath bl Eph 1:4 ASV ... he chose us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blemish before him in love essed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ

Eph 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved.

Eph 1:7 KJV In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

Eph 1:15-16 Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints, (16) Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers;

Eph 1:18 CEV My prayer is that light will flood your hearts and that you will understand the hope that was given to you when God chose you. Then you will discover the glorious blessings that will be yours together with all of God's people.

Eph 1:19-20 CEV I want you to know about the great and mighty power that God has for us followers. It is the same wonderful power he used (20) when he raised Christ from death and let him sit at his right side in heaven.

Eph 2:1-5 ESV And you were dead in the trespasses and sins ...(4) But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, (5) even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved

Eph 2:6 KJV And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus

Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God

Eph 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

Eph 2:19 KJV Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow citizens with the saints, and of the household of God.

Eph 2:22 In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.

Eph 3:7 Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power.

Eph 3:8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ

Eph 3:16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man

Eph 3:17-19 That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being **rooted and grounded in love**, May be able to comprehend with all saints what *is* the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And **to know the love** of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might **be filled with all the fulness of God**.

Eph 3:20-21 Weymouth Now to Him who, in exercise of His power that is at work within us, is able to do infinitely beyond all our highest prayers or thoughts-- to Him be the glory in the Church and in Christ Jesus to all generations, world without end! Amen.

Eph 4:1 BBE 2-3 ESV I then, the prisoner in the Lord, make this request from my heart, that you will see that your behaviour is a credit to the position which God's purpose has given you, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Eph 4:4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling

Eph 4:7 ... unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.

Eph 4:12 ... for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ

Eph 4:15 ... speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, *even* Christ Eph 4:16 [Christ] From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

Eph 4:17-20 This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, (18) Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of

their heart: (19) Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. (20) But ye have not so learned Christ;

Eph 4:22-24 That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; (23) And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; (24) And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness.

Eph 4:27 GW Don't give the devil any opportunity to work.

Eph 4:25 ... speak every man truth with his neighbor for we are members one of another.

Eph 4:29 KJV Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

Eph 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

Eph 4:32 RV ... be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving each other, even as God also in Christ forgave you.

Eph 5:1 Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children

Eph 5:2 And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

Eph 5:3-4 But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, **as becometh saints**; Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: **but rather giving of thanks**.

Eph 5:8 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now *are ye* light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

Eph 5:9 ASV ... the fruit of the light is in all goodness and righteousness and truth Eph 5:10 Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.

Eph 5:13 But all things that are reproved are made <u>manifest</u> by the light: for whatsoever doth make <u>manifest</u> is light.

Eph 5:14 Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.

Eph 5:15 See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise

Eph 5:16 Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.

Eph 5:17 Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is.

Eph 5:18 ... be filled with the Spirit

Eph 5:19 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord

Eph 5:20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ

Eph 5:21 ... submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

Eph 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it

Eph 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word

Eph 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Eph 5:32 This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.

Eph 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

Eph 6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

<u>Eph 6:12</u> For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Eph 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Eph 6:16 Weymouth And besides all these take the great shield of faith, on which you will be able to quench all the flaming darts of the Wicked one;

Eph 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation...

Eph 6:17 And take ... the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God

Eph 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints

Eph 6:23-24 Peace be to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.

Phil 1:29 Diaglott Because to you it was graciously given on BEHALF of Christ, not only to BELIEVE into Him, but also to suffer on His account

Php 3:9 KJV And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:

Php 3:14-15 KJV I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. (15) Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded: and if in any thing ye be otherwise minded, God shall reveal even this unto you.

Php 3:17,20 KJV Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample ... For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:

Jas 1:22-25 But *be ye doers of the word*, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. (23) For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: (24) For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. (25) But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth *therein*, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, *this man shall be blessed in his deed*.
